



WAIPARA PINOT NOIR 2019

VINEYARD

The Crater Rim Waipara Pinot Noir fruit was sourced from two vineyards in the Waipara Valley. The vines were low cropped and sustainably managed to provide fruit of great flavour depth, structure and integrity.

SOIL TYPE

50% Silty clay overlaying calcareous sandy gravels 50% Sedimentary calcareous clay

WINEMAKING

The fruit was fermented in small open top vats, using natural yeasts followed by 15 months maturation on lees in new and seasoned French oak barriques. After barrel maturation, the wine was bottled without fining or filtration.

TASTING NOTES

Gorgeously ripe and inviting with dark cherry, sweet plum, floral, hazelnut and subtle mushroom aromas, the wine offers terrific fruit concentrated and persistency, while remaining elegant and harmonious. Sam Kim, Wine Orbit.
